- Decrease of major behaviours incidents to achieve a minimum standard of: Tier 1 95% or greater
- Ensure that schoolwide attendance is equal to or greater than 95%

- Working as a part of the SER Inclusive Teaching of Reading PLC to build a common shared understanding of best practice in teaching students to be skilled readers (Scarborough, 2001. Reading Rope)
- Participation in the SER Leading Learning Collaborative project with Lyn Sharratt with a specific focus to -
 - ✓ Progress staff knowledge, understanding and application in the development of learning walls to support students to monitor their own performance (Sharratt, L. (2019) Clarity – What Matters Most in Learning, Teaching and Leading)
 - ✓ Implement an English Data Wall as a preventative strategy that is supported by a Case Management approach as intervention to inform the next steps for learning
